With extreme heat conditions forecast for the next while everyone should make sure that they have proper sun protection and keep themselves well hydrated while on the course. Yet when the fairways start to show some heat stress it is very important to make sure that you keep the carts off all approaches and please drive mainly in the rough to reduce the traffic marks on the fairway. The bunker edging has been started and we will finish them as quickly as possible to make sure that there is plenty of time to put the Texas Wedges away and bring out the sand wedge. The second cut of rough is back and we will top dress the greens as soon as I get a break in the heat so as not to add more stress to the greens at this time. The large amount of clover has now become enemy number one and we will start spraying later this week.

Our Club events have been very popular with the members and I look forward to seeing everyone this Friday for our First Pig Roast party which is being sponsored by Mike Masterman, courtesy of Labatt's. Hope to see you there!!

THREE-MAN CLASSIC 2010

This year's Three-Man Classic will take place on Saturday, August 21st. The team draw has been changed from Wednesday, August 18th to **Tuesday, August 17th at 8:00 p.m.** for anyone interested in attending.

The format of the tournament will be teams consisting of an A, B and C player based upon the handicaps of those individuals who register. These handicaps will be determined by each player's **index factor** and not necessarily the handicap that you see on the computer screen. In order to qualify, the maximum handicap that a player can have will be **24** and all participants will have to have played a minimum of **fifteen 18-hole games** this year prior to the Tuesday draw.

Similar to last year, we will be using the **white** tee blocks and will be **counting two net scores on each hole.**

The cost this year is **\$130.00** which will be charged to your account when you register for this tournament. This is only a \$5.00 increase over last year's cost.

Registration tickets will become available **July 1st** and can be obtained **at the bar only.**

In order to encourage early registration, we will be holding an **EARLY BIRD DRAW** for all participants who register by *midnight on Monday, August 2nd*. The Early Bird prize is an electric cart package valued at approximately \$275.00. For this Early Bird draw to take place, we must have a minimum of 60 registrants by the August 2nd deadline.
