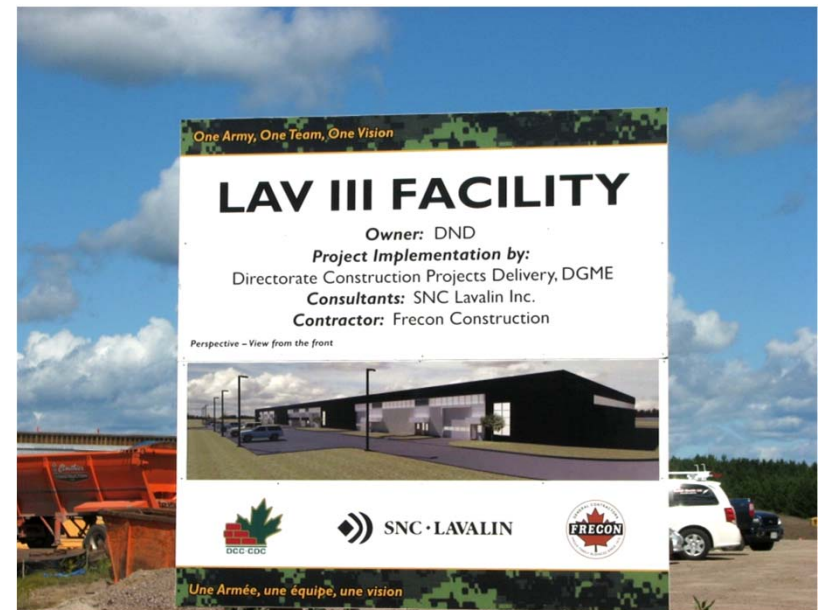


## Highlights/Summary of Key Points – Slide 2

- Major Economic Impact/Lifeblood of the Community
  - Single largest employer in the Ottawa Valley
  - Multi-million dollars operating budgets
  - Estimated 400 million dollars pushed back into the local communities in salaries alone
- Integrated into community events (education, charities, fundraising, advocacy, and awareness)
- Retiring members and families represent purchasing power, skilled and often bilingual labour pool (with diverse skills and expertise)

- 2 CMBG Sigs Bldg - 37M/complete
- Training Accommodations - 16.5M/Feb 11/Jun 12
- LAV III Storage Facility - 18M/Oct 10/Sep 12
- \*MHLH - 158M + 13M/Dec 10/Jul 13



# Growth and Development Initiatives (Slide 2)

- 4 Major Infrastructure Projects in the Design Phase (57.5M \$ anticipated over the next 2 to 4 years):

## **(Project)/(Cost)**

– Health Care Facility	42M
– Server Building	8M
– SNIC Facility	3.85M
– Fire/Crash Response Facility	3.7M

- 12 Major Infrastructure Projects in the Initial Scope Phase (estimated 500M \$ out to 2022)



# What Makes Us A Unique Asset

- Above the immediate economic impact, the presence of a CF Base can be beneficial in:
  - Provide shared and unique resources;
  - Provide the potential to quickly raise community, local, and or regional issues to the provincial /national/federal levels (eg. access to medical and speciality services in semi-rural areas);
